Set Up:

Since we are all crating on the gymnasium floor, we have decided to assign crating locations. We will be following the NAFA guidelines of a 10×10 space per line up entered. Everything is fairly close so, your location is not going to be more or less relevant to the access of the lanes, potty area, etc. We do ask that you bring tarps to lie under your crates for additional protection for the floor. We will be allowing set up Friday this year at 4:30pm til 6pm (we MUST be out by 6pm) if you would like to come and take advantage of this time please do.

Special Notes: IMPORTANT TO SHARE WITH YOUR TEAM

The entire gym floor will have a heavy gauge tarp over it. We ask that if you have additional ground cover to please bring and lay it under your dogs kennel areas.

There is to be NO UNCONTAINED WATER or food allowed on the gymnasium floor. Water that is in bottles or very small amounts in a bowl can be in your dogs kennels. The rest of the water can be kept in the locker rooms (right off the racing lanes) where you can leave your team water and allow your dogs to lap up all the water they want:)

Food:

You are welcome to bring in ANY food you want. Our tournament page lists some places in the area that will deliver. Food is not allowed on the gymnasium floor. You can eat and drink ANYWHERE else you want. There will be a quiet room and the lobby available for eating areas. This year we will have Reef's Kitchen (by popular demand from a Crazy Train Tournament) ... serving up food both days.

Potty Area:

Potty Area will be designated. It is a mostly shaded area outside that consists of gravel. if you can keep this area as tidy as possible that would be wonderful. Please pick up after your dogs.

Hot, Hot, Hot!!!

When leaving at the end of the day please take WARNING of the very hot surface to walk your dogs on. We will have K9 Outlaws team members available to hold your dogs as you pull up to load. Again please do not walk your dogs on the extremely hot concrete or asphalt when you leave. Ouch!!!

Red Light Bucket:

What is the Red Light Bucket? For every red light that you or your teammates incur, we ask that you make a small monetary donation to the Red Light Bucket. Funds collected over the weekend will be donated to the Arizona Disabled Sports (Saturday) and Pawsitive Friendships (Sunday).
